

Preface

Welcome to the inaugural issue of the Journal of Global Communication Studies 『神戸学院大学グローバル・コミュニケーション学会紀要』, published by the Society of Global Communication Studies of Kobe Gakuin University.

On April 1, 2015, the Faculty of Global Communication of Kobe Gakuin University was launched with the goal of nurturing students who can actively participate in a globally interconnected world. Three courses are offered in English, Chinese and Japanese studies, with the Japanese course being for overseas students. The courses aim to have their students develop the ability to fluently and effectively use the language that they are learning in small-group environments, where they can actively practice their skills and also have hands-on experience in interacting and working with students from different backgrounds in an atmosphere of mutual respect.
